Regarding: Cabot Elementary School Notice of Intent for Commencement of Water Service Work Bridges Ave

Dear Neighbors,

The purpose of this letter is to inform you that we will be performing water service work in the right of way on Bridges Ave, Newton, MA for the new Cabot Elementary School.

This work will take place on Tuesday, October 10, 2017. During this time, there will be a water service shutdown between approximately 9:00 AM and 1:00 PM to facilitate this work and you will have <u>no water service</u> to your property.

The work will be performed per the City of Newton ordinances and Police details will be present to direct traffic as necessary.

We will make every effort to expedite this work to minimize the length of time the water will be shut down.

Please note that this scheduled water shut down is subject to change due to weather and/or other variable conditions which may arise. You will be notified as soon as possible if this work is to be rescheduled or extended.

Also note that after the water is restored you may notice some discoloration of your water. We recommend you run your cold water until clear before consumption or doing laundry.
