CONSTRUCTION ACTIVITIES

- Abatement of existing windows is expected to be complete 10/13.
- Demolition inside the 1929 building is almost complete.
- All footing demolition is complete where the 1956 building stood.
- · Temporary lighting and electric is complete.
- Temporary stair tower is installed and is being used for the demolition of existing stair in the 1929 building.
- Sitework demolition at #15 Parkview Ave is complete.
- Culvert activities are under way, with anticipated completion the end of November.
- Bridges Avenue work is well ahead of the scheduled finish date, up to the new culvert connection at Bridges.
- Both site security/time lapse cameras are installed and are operational.
- Dewatering system is up and running, as well as the point well system, to keep the water table below working elevation.
