CONSTRUCTION ACTIVITIES

 Temporary heat is operating 24/7 per specifications, to control indoor building temperature; readings are being recorded.

- Culvert activities are ongoing with anticipated completion towards end of December.
- Bridges Avenue underground work is complete. Paving will be completed pending need for pumps for culvert work.
- Site cameras are operatational. There have been no security issues.
- Dewatering system remains in operation and activity is ongoing.
- At the classroom addition to the north of the existing building, footings and foundation walls are ongoing at the north classroom additon, including excavation, backfill and concrete placement.
- Per Owner request, additional parking has been provided for #15 Parkview. When culvert work is complete, the driveway will be replaced.
- Batting cages have been relocated. The batting cage area will be backfilled with loam and irrigation and sod installed.
- The baseball/softball field has been relocated.
- Wires were removed from poles on Parkview Ave, in preparation of utility pole relocation/removal.
- Eversource met with the City and the Contractor to resolve all pole locations with regard to traffic flow at the school.
