CONSTRUCTION ACTIVITIES

- Temporary heat is no longer required.
- Final paving at Bridges Ave. and neighbor's lawn repairs are in the process of being coordinated and scheduled.

- Classroom addition Steel erection is 100% and detailing is ongoing. Slab placement at floors 2 and 3 is scheduled for early May.
- Library addition Steel erection is 100%; detailing is ongoing, nearing completion. Slab on grade is scheduled for mid-May.
- Gym addition Steel erection is 100% with detailing ongoing.
- Structural shear wall foundations are anticipated to be placed in early May.
- Masonry interior work will commence in early to mid-May.
- Initial washdown of the 1929 building is 90% complete.
- Camera #2 function is being addressed. There have been no security issues.
- Underground (UG) plumbing excavation has started and will be done in early May; UG plumbing and electrical installation will begin shortly.
- MEP coordination is 85% complete.
- Site drainage and sewer structures/ piping is ongoing.
- Water main relocation is complete around the gym.
- Utility poles removed from the jobsite; one is remaining.
- Irrigation and electrical meter for Little League is installed; power pending.
